



DECISION N° **18260241** MINESUP/SG/DAUQ/SDEAC OF **28 MAI 2026**

Launching the competitive entrance examination into the **Third Year** of the engineering training program at the National Advanced School of Maritime and Ocean Science and Technology (NASMOST) of the University of Ebolowa, and defining the number of places opened for the 2026/2027.

THE MINISTER OF STATE, MINISTER OF HIGHER EDUCATION:

Mindful of the Constitution;
Mindful of the Law n°2023/007 of 25th July 2023 setting up Higher Education Orientation in Cameroon;
Mindful of Decree n°2011/408 of 09th December 2011 organizing the Government;
Mindful of Decree 93/026 of the 19th January 1993 to create Universities;
Mindful of Decree n°2005/342 of 10th September 2005 modifying and completing certain dispositions of Decree n°93/027 of 19 January 1993 fixing common dispositions in Universities;
Mindful of Decree n°2009/008 of 12th January 2009 appointing authorities in State Universities;
Mindful of Decree n°2012/433 of 01st October 2012 organizing the Ministry of Higher Education;
Mindful of Decree n°2018/190 of 02nd March 2018, completing certain dispositions of Decree n°2011/408 of 09th December organizing the Government;
Mindful of Decree n°2019/002 of 04th January 2019 reshuffling the Government;
Mindful of Decree n°2022/003 of 05th January 2022 creating universities;
Mindful of Decree n°2022/009 of 06th January 2022 laying down the administrative and academic organization of the University of Ebolowa;
Mindful of Decree n°2023/302 of 04th July 2023 appointing authorities in certain State Universities;
Mindful of Decision n°18250145/MINESUP/SGDAUQ/SDEAC of 07th April 2025 setting up the calendar for competitive entrance examinations into Cameroon State Universities and Schools under the Academic Tutelage of the Ministry of Higher Education for the 2026-2027 academic year;

On the proposal of the Vice-Chancellor of the University of Ebolowa;

DECIDES:

Article 1 :

- (1) A written competition entrance examination for the admission of **seventy (70)** students, divided by specializations in the table below, into the third year at the National School of Maritime and Ocean Science and Technology (NASMOST) of the: **Kribi, Bafoussam, Bertoua, Buca, Douala, Ebolowa, Garoua and Yaoundé.**
- (2) The certificates needed to be eligible for the competitive admission exam are listed in the table below based on the training fields.

Article 2: The following are concerned:

- For **Port and Maritime Management**: All DUT and DEUG Degrees, all Bachelors Degrees or any other degree that the Ministry of Higher Education deems comparable
- For the **others areas of training**: candidates with a Bachelor of Science, Engineering or Technology, a Scientific Diploma (DUT, DEUG), Higher Education deemed equivalent;
- Candidates preparing in 2025/2026 for the diplomas as mentioned above.

Article 3:

- (1) The competition programs are those of the classes preparing for the abovementioned diplomas of the type "GCE/A1+2". Depending on the candidates' original training specialty it comprises a 3-hour written specialty test.
- (2) No oral examination will take place.

Article 4: Candidates registered subject to one of the above-mentioned diplomas will be definitively admitted to NASMOST, in case of successful completion of the competition, only upon presentation of the original diploma obtained at the 2026 examination session or, if applicable, Certificate of Completion: at the time of registration set by NASMOST.

Article 5: The application files shall comprise the following documents:

1. Application form to be filled online at the website <http://www.enstmo-ueb.cm>, then downloaded and stamped at 1500 CFA francs by the candidate;
2. A certified true Copy of the national identity card;
3. A certified true copy of the birth certificate dated not more than three (03) months;
4. A certified true copy of the diploma entitling to the competition or an attestation of successful completion of this diploma, if applicable, signed by a competent administrative authority;
5. A certified true copy of the last two or three years spent at the University institution that awarded the diploma or certificate of achievement;
6. A certified true copy of the GCE/AL or Baccalaureate transcripts dated not more than three (03) months, as the case may be;
7. A medical certificate dated not more than three (03) months issued by a public medical practitioner.





8. An envelope bearing a CFA 1000 FCFA stamp and the candidate's address;
9. Four (04) passport-size photographs bearing the candidate's name and surname on the back;
10. A letter of release from the employer in case of success in the competition (for salaried candidates)
11. Working-class candidates must justify their professional experiences.

Article 6: The registration fee for the competition entrance exam is twenty thousand (20,000) FCFA as and it must be placed at CCA BANK account N° 10039101200272769801-29 and the receipt should be joined to the candidate's file. These non-refundable fees are intended to cover the expenses generated by the organization of the competitive examination. Any other method of payment is excluded;

Article 7: complete application files must be deposited by **Friday 11th September 2026** at Administrative building of the National Advanced School of Maritime and Ocean Science and Technology (NASMOST) in Kribi or at the departmental delegation of the Ministry of Secondary Education at Kribi, as well as the regional delegations of the Ministry of Secondary Education.

Article 8: only candidates who have a complete regulatory file will be allowed to participate in the exams. They must also bring their national identity cards or their student card and the entrance examination registration receipt (to be downloaded) as these will be necessary.

Article 9: Candidates for the third-year entrance examination must be **thirty-two (32) years old** at most, on January 1st, 2025, the year of the examination.

Article 10: The entrance examination will take place on **Sunday 20th September 2026**. at the centers mentioned above.

Article 11: The Vice-Chancellor of the University of Ebolowa, the Director of Department of University Accreditations and Quality and the Director of the National Advanced School of Maritime and Ocean Science and Technology (NASMOST) are responsible, each in his/her respective capacity, for the implementation of this Decision which shall be registered and published in English and French wherever necessary.
